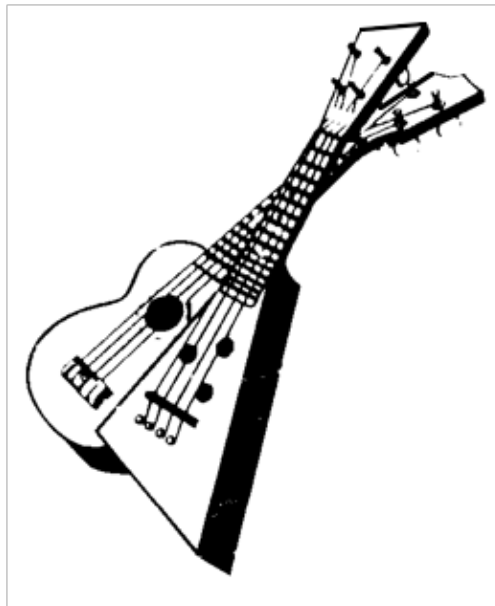

About our logo: The “twin ukes” logo was developed by J. Chalmers Doane when he started the Ukulele in the Classroom program in the early ‘70’s. It represents the melding of the two styles of ukuleles used in the Canadian schools back then. The triangle shaped ukulele can still be found in many of the classrooms. Today, most of the schools have reverted back to the traditional guitar-like shape.
